

Nexus Installation Guide

Step 1: Create a folder

Navigate to the “C:\” directory on your computer and create a new folder. Rename the folder “NEXUS”

Step 2: Download the ZIP file

Download the Nexus.zip file from the link provided in the email. Navigate to the downloads folder on your computer and move the Nexus.zip file to the NEXUS folder you created on step 1.

Step 3: Extract the files

Right click on the Nexus.zip file and select either “Extract here” or “Extract All...” If you use the “Extract All...” command, change the path in the popup dialog from “C:\NEXUS\NEXUS” to “C:\NEXUS” and click ok. The files will then take a few moments to be extracted.

Step 4: Launch Nexus console

Double click on the “Nexus Console.exe” file to launch the program. If there is a security warning, click on “[more info](#)” near the top left and select “run anyway”. The software will start and display a Splash screen with a progress bar and brief message that there is no license. The main software window will display after a few moments. In order to use the software, refer to the Nexus User Manual.

Step 5: Obtaining a license

This is a licensed software. A license file containing a unique hexadecimal license code is required for live capture operation. To obtain a license, the hexadecimal uniqueID of the PC where the software is going to be operated needs to be sent to bastiman@bizmuthmbe.com. **Ensure that the UniqueID is obtained by running the software on the PC where it is intended to be used.** Once the UniqueID has been received, a license file will be returned containing the hexadecimal licence code.

The UniqueID is copied to the clipboard on software start in Simulation mode or can be obtained anytime on the “About” form in the bottom right corner of the application.

Appendix: Virus protection exclusions

Note: On some occasions the windows defender virus software can remove the “Nexus Console.exe” and “Backend.dll” files. To prevent this, you need to add an exclusion to the Nexus folder created in step 1. To do this:

1. Click on the windows start menu icon in the bottom left corner and then type “windows security” and hit enter.

2. Select virus and threat protection
3. Select the blue “manage settings” option under virus and thread protection settings
4. Scroll down to “exclusions” and select “add/remove exclusions”
5. Select yes if a security pop up appears
6. Select “+ add exclusion” and then select “folder”
7. Navigate to and select the NEXUS folder in the C:\ directory
8. Click select folder
